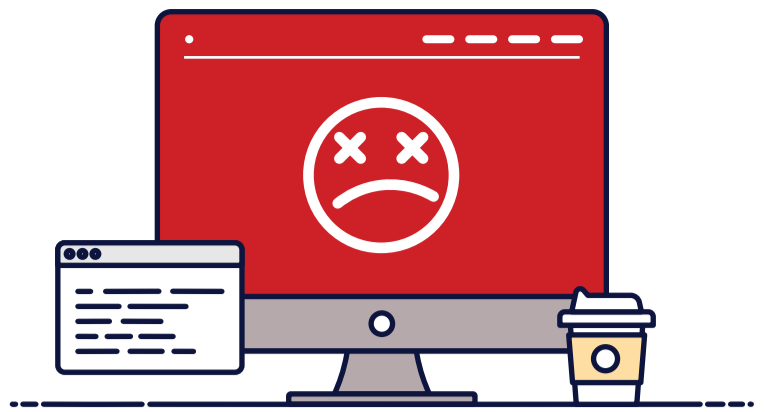


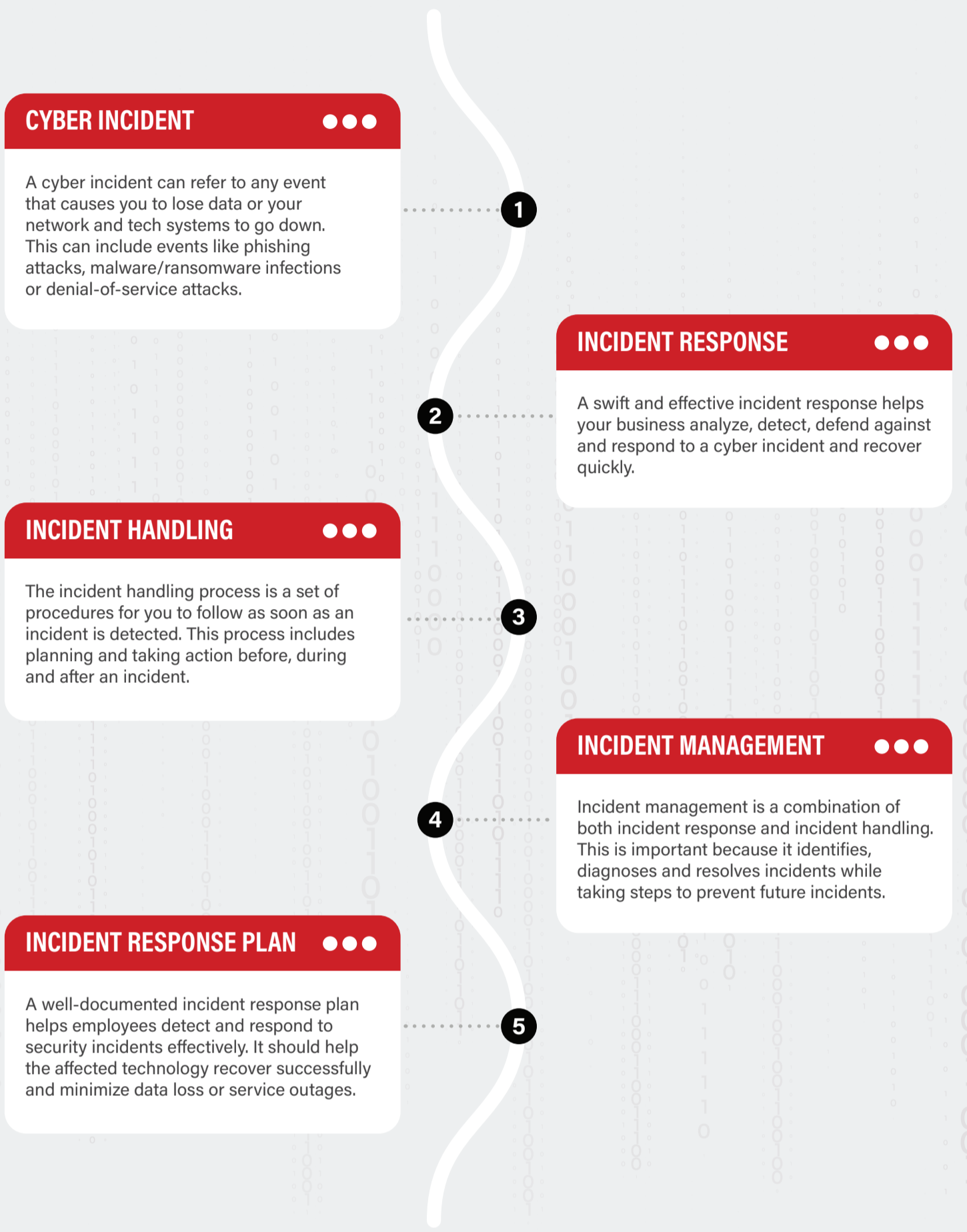
IS YOUR BUSINESS PREPARED FOR A CYBER INCIDENT?



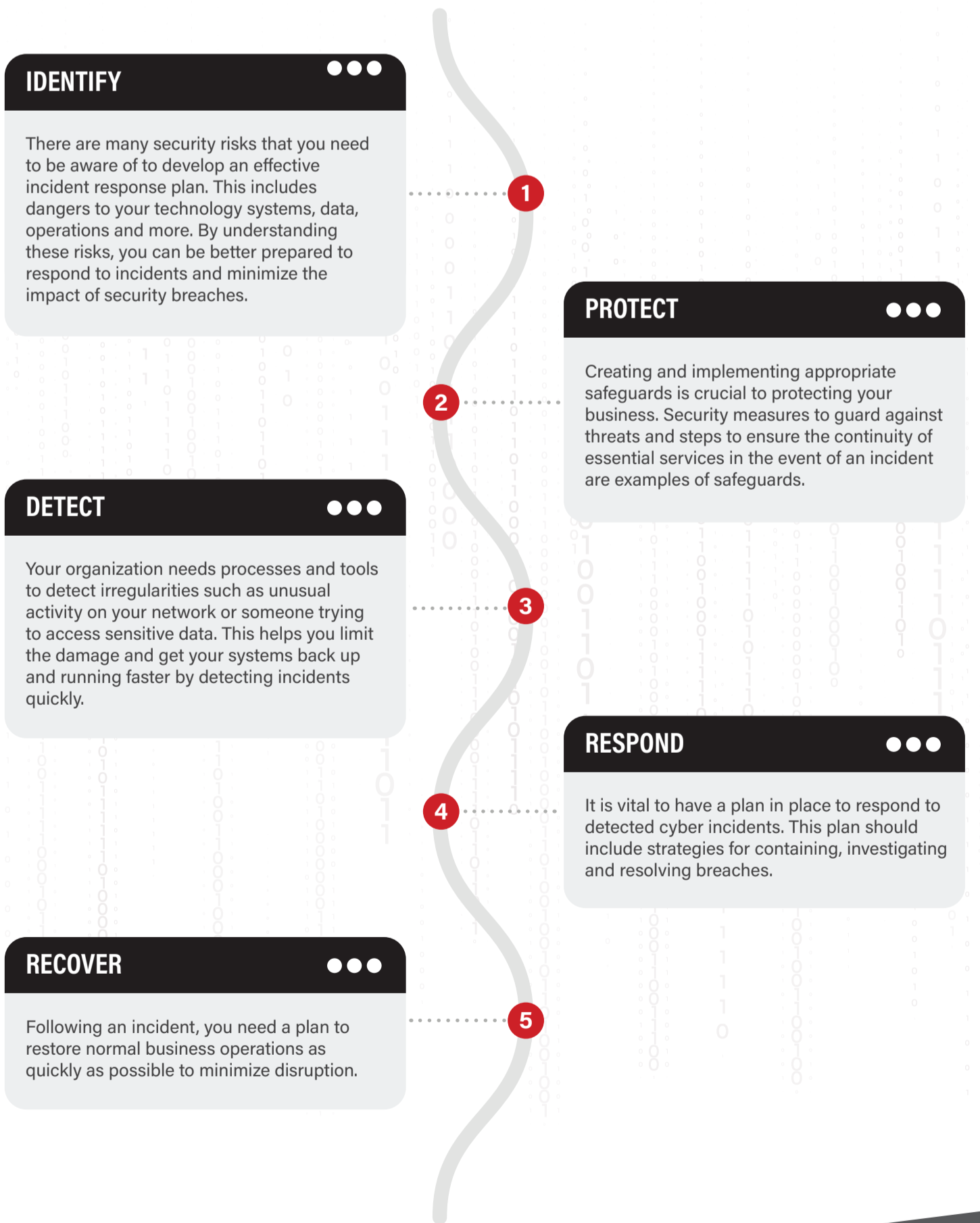
